Routes currently are no more than 40 minutes long – Can place 71 students on a bus

Fleet size is 42 busses and is leased for one year – Busses have to be kept in perfect condition

RGS has 13 routes (morning and afternoon)

SGE has 9 routes (morning and afternoon)

NMS and RBCHS has 22 routes (morning and afternoon)

4 Vans – Mainly used for Special Ed. Students, meetings, coaches

8.6 miles currently between RGS and SGE
