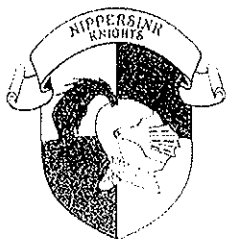

Dear Parents/Guardians:

As the date for Springfield approaches I wanted to send out a few reminders to help make the trip successful and safe for all those involved.

1. Arrive at NMS between 4:00 – 4:15 a.m. We have a schedule to follow so **bus will leave at 4:30 a.m.**
2. Make sure that medication is clearly marked with your student's name and instructions to dispense. Medication should be placed in a clear zip lock bag and handed to a chaperone when your student checks in.
3. Bring a lunch for the bus on Thursday.
4. Students are responsible for any electronic devices they bring.
5. All drinks should be in a re-sealable bottle.
6. Our arrival back at NMS is tentatively scheduled for 11:00 p.m. Students will call from the bus when we are approximately a half hour away.
7. Students are allowed to bring one carry-on bag such as a day pack and one piece of luggage to be stowed. Space on the bus is limited so I recommend students use a small carry-on bag.
8. Students' cell phones will be allowed on the trip. Any inappropriate use of the cell phone will result in the loss of phone privileges.
9. As with all overnight trips, students' rooms and belongings are subject to searches at any point.
